Resurrection Story Matthew 28:1-10

Leader: After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb.

People: There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it.

Leader: His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.

Declaring the Resurrection

I Corinthians 15

Leader: For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

People: that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve.

Leader: After that, he appeared to more than five hundred people at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

People: Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

Leader: If it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?

People: If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.

All: BUT!!!

Leader: Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have died. When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true:

People: “Death has been swallowed up in victory.”

Leader: “Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?”

People: The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
