The Gospel of Incarnation

John 1:1-5; 10-14

Leader: The Word was first, the Word present to God, God present to the Word. The Word was God, in readiness for God from day one.

People: Everything was created through him; nothing—not one thing!—came into being without him. What came into existence was Life, and the Life was Light to live by.

Leader: The Life-Light blazed out of the darkness; the darkness couldn't put it out. The Life-Light was the real thing:

Every person entering Life he brings into Light.

People: He was in the world, the world was there through him, and yet the world didn't even notice. He came to his own people, but they didn't want him.

Leader: But whoever did want him, who believed he was who he claimed and would do what he said, He made to be their true selves, their child-of-God selves.

People: These are the God-begotten, not blood-begotten, not flesh-begotten, not sex-begotten.

Leader: The Word became flesh and blood, and moved into the neighborhood.

People: We saw the glory with our own eyes, the one-of-a-kind glory, like Father, like Son, Generous inside and out, true from start to finish.

The Gospel of the Cross

I Corinthians 1:18-28; 2:2

Leader: For the word of the cross is folly to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

People: For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart."

Leader: Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world?

People: For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, it pleased God through the folly of what we preach to save those who believe.

Leader: For Jews demand signs and Greeks seek wisdom, but we preach Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and folly to Gentiles, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

People: For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

All: For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified.

The Gospel of Resurrection

I Corinthians 15

Leader: For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,

People: that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Peter, and then to the Twelve.

Leader: After that, he appeared to more than five hundred people at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep.

People: Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

Leader: If it is preached that Christ has been raised from the dead, how can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?

People: If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.

All: BUT!!!

Leader: Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have died. When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true:

People: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

Leader: "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" People: The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
